Wisdom in challenging times

- Key texts: 1 Corinthians 2:6-9 & John 14:1-6.

The Bible shows its real-life credentials by not skipping over difficult matters. Paul writes to his church in Corinth amidst all kinds of difficulties amidst questions, Jesus speaks to his disciples at the Last Supper to address their concerns over what was about to happen. Both point to the unshakeable and outlandish hope those who love the Lord have through him.

1, 1 Corinthians 2:6-9

- What comfort do you find in Paul's words?
- Why do you think Paul speaks of these things ahead of getting to the details of their issues?
- What might he hope the result be?

2, John 14:1-6

- What is your understanding of Jesus' description of his Father's House?
- How many promises can you find in this short passage? What do they mean to you in good times and difficult?
- How can the disciples have known where Jesus was going or how to get there before Jesus' pivotal statement of being the Way, Truth and Life?
- How can we communicate these truths to others?
